| Leisure Centre Procurement Strategy | <p>Work is continuing at Cranleigh Leisure Centre and the Multi-purpose room and crèche are now available for use. The poolside Glazing will now be upgraded as part of the refurbishment which will improve the look and feel of the pool area considerably. Extra work is also taking place in the pool tank and we are waiting to see if this will delay the opening of the pool.</p> <p>Work is well under way at Farnham Sports Centre, starting with the front of the building. This includes reception, the gym, the swimming pools and the wetside changing areas, these areas are currently unavailable for use and will be until the end of March. Work is progressing well.</p> <p>Council have now given the go ahead to a new Godalming Leisure Centre. The project team is currently being established which will mirror those involved with the refurbishment programme with the key addition of a Green Advisor. The OJEU notice has been logged and a project plan for starting work on a new centre in 2011 has been prepared.</p> | Continuing | K Mills |

| Air Quality Action Plan | <p>Progress update:</p> <p>The AQAP Annual Progress Report was presented to ELOS in March 2009, prior to its submission to defra (Department for Environment Food and Rural Affairs) by the 29 April deadline. The report has been accepted by defra and a 6-month review was asked for by ELOS: due end of October. The Council's Air Quality Officer post became vacant in June and recruitment of the new post was in line with the Councils formal policy. Only statutory undertakings (diffusion tube monitoring, reduced operation of Air Quality continuous monitoring equipment, etc) were covered in the meantime and the Action Plan's projects had not progressed. The Council's Budget Review reduced the capital budget for air quality measures, for 2009/10, by £10,000 to £5,000.</p> <p>However, the recruitment process has now been completed and a new Air Quality Officer has been in post since 2nd November 2009. Now that induction training is complete the new officer is concentrating on pursuing and / or completing the projects in the AQAP. A draft Annual Progress Report will be received by ELOS in March 2010.</p> | April 2010 and ongoing | C Giddings |
