P.F.1780 Munstead Oaks, Busbridge

Correspondence was received from the Surrey County Council asking that an investigation be made into what appear to be engineering operations being carried out at Munstead Oaks, Busbridge. The Clerk was instructed to write to the owner with a view to ascertaining what is being done, and to see whether a planning permit is necessary. It was also resolved to recommend that an Article 4 Direction be made on the land in question to prevent its being used for new uses without planning consent.
