2. Key Consultee Groups (3)

Environment Agency

- Would like the objectives to refer to managing and reducing flood risk (ref SFRA) as well as mitigating impacts on climate change – perhaps a separate objective.

Natural England

- Recommended that the vision refers to green infrastructure – if this happens it needs to be continued on to objectives.

English Heritage

- Support the objectives.

3. Town & Parish Councils (3)

- How can further development be sustained when infrastructure is already overstretched? (Wonersh Parish Council)

4. National & Local Organisations (3)

- Should be re-titled 'Core Strategy Objectives' so terminology is consistent with introduction of objectives at the beginning of each chapter (Friends of the Earth)
- Should WBC place a moratorium on further development in certain areas where there is increased migration (Haslemere Society)

5. Developers/Agents/Land Owners (3)

- First & fifth bullet points should refer to the needs of the future population as well as the current in terms of housing provision, in line with para 33 of PPS3 (Croudace Strategic)
- Third & fourth objectives will not be met due to restricted housing targets (Mr Nick Vrijland, West Cranleigh Nurseries)

6. Individuals (7)

- How will these objectives be /measured monitored (SMART) (4 respondents)
- Would like to see continued access to services by foot (1 respondent)
